External Functions Manager

The External Functions Manager (EFM) will be responsible for obtaining, booking, managing and monitoring or corporate, community and private functions to be held at Bowls Matua.

The role is defined as being a casual appointment where remuneration will be in the form of a percentage of the income from functions obtained or retained, as well as an hourly rate for administration components. Note that Club members may also seek and retain clients, for which there will be no remuneration relative to Hire Charges; this also applies to booking made by Go Bananas. Remuneration will be paid for the administration component of these bookings.

The role is to provide all that is required to ensure that the client has a successful function, within the policies of the Board regarding which type of functions are acceptable.

Functions Barperson

The Barperson is responsible for the provision of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks to guests at a corporate, community or private function.

The role is defined as being a casual appointment where remuneration will be in the form of an hourly rate.

The role is to provide a bar service that the client and guests have a successful function, and to maintain a clean and organized work environment.

Bowls Instructor

The Bowls Instructor is responsible for the set up and running of bowling activities where part of an external function.

The role is defined as being a casual appointment where remuneration will be in the form of an hourly rate.

The role is to provide all that is required to ensure that the client has a successful function by assisting guests with bowling activities.
