Pro-rata for new members joining during the year (not Social):

1st July to 30th September	100% of annual membership

Club Members are categorised as Full, Limited, Associate or Social.

Limited Members can play at Matua only, not other Clubs.

Club and Casual Members are permitted to access the clubrooms and bar any time they are open.

Club Members can access the library and are eligible for the membership draw, Casual Members cannot.

Club Members, except for Associate, have voting rights at General Meetings.

Club Members can access the greens for practice at no additional cost; Casual Members can access the greens for practice on payment of the green fee.
