# Update on Synthetic Project

Ben O'Connell, Berry Bowling Rep., has completed the excavation of the grassed areas surrounding greens 1 & 2 and the initial rock layer base has been applied. To complete, a finer layer will be applied, then the synthetic grass weighted down with an application of sand. The completion of this surrounding area will be the last phase of the contract.

It is important to remove these grassed areas as this prevents seeds and other material from being walked onto the new greens themselves.

Murray Brunning and his helpers have been completing an edging around the gardens and hedge lines for the new synthetic surrounds to abut.

Next Monday, 4th July, the company owner attending to the removal of about 100/120mm of surface from the existing greens will discuss their work on site with Ben, and the heavy-duty equipment required will commence the following day.

The two containers beside the drive to the club contain the carpet and underlay and the third container has the equipment Berrys need to handle their side of the duties.

It's great to see the start now so close and even with a bad run of weather (the guy above knows we have already had more than our share of delays) all should be safely completed by end of August.

Steven Rogerson from Berry Bowling is overseeing the contract from Melbourne - most of you will know he an accident on site about a month ago and suffered a very painful fracture of a cheekbone. His recovery is coming along well but he is still unable to chew a good steak! We do expect him to join the contract in 10 days or so - he is so very keen to do so.

We will keep you up to date with progress, and the next newsletter will include a better idea of the expected timing of future work phases.
