Project Synthetic Update

Around 66 truckloads of soil have been removed from Greens 1 and 2. 4 lines of drainage have been laid on green 2 as per the attached photo. Ben O'Connell from Berry Bowling Systems is down with the flu' at the moment but will be back later this coming week, I'm sure.

More thanks to Murray Bruning and his team - they have just completed the laying of concrete between the gardens of green 1, gardens and the shelter/seating. Upon completion of the total contract the surroundings to both greens 1 and 2 will be all concrete or landscape synthetics. This will ensure no lawn cuttings, seeds etc can be transferred onto the new synthetic greens.
