Project Synthetic Update

Hello members,

The attached photo taken on Saturday 23rd July shows continued progress of the Synthetic Project notwithstanding three days continual rain through the week.

It was great to see project contractors all on deck today to endeavour to catch up on lost time. This shows that drainage has already been laid to green 1 (running east to west) and hooking up with the drainage to council stormwater: the coming week will see the finer metal deliveries being made and laid on green 1. In the background Paul Steiner is levelling the finer metal on green 2.

Ben O'Connell from Berry Sports Surfaces returns on-site next Thursday to ensure continuity of the project and to do further work on the surrounding areas.

The Laser levelling contractor has been delayed a little due to rain affecting his other projects but is booked to commence work at Bowls Matua on 3 August.

We are still hopeful that weather will permit the total contract to be completed around the end of August.

You are all aware of the great work done by such a competent team of member experts over the last few weeks and months.

After the synthetic loomed carpet has been laid this team lead for the final work by Ross Dean will complete the new numbering and rink marking, the plan for which has already been completed.
