Project Synthetic Update

Hello members,

Another week has passed with 3 days lost due to rain. The photo of green 2 shows it is almost at a stage where on this coming Thursday cement will be applied and rotary mixed in, followed by further laser levelling. The green will then be flooded and allowed to drain and "set" still allowing drainage. A low level of sand will then be applied and again levelled off. This green will then be ready for under-felt and the woven carpet.

Ben O'Connell from Berry Sports Surface worked through the week end to try and catch up, and Murray Bruning was there also for several hours for woodwork repairs to damage accidentally caused by machinery.

As you can just see in the photo at bottom left landscaping carpet is already being laid to the areas surrounding green 2. To contain this carpet within the laid areas, 8 kgs of sand per square metre is applied and this weight holds the landscape carpet in place. This landscaping surrounding the greens needs to be completed before the new bowling green can be used to prevent other materials being walked on.

Drainage for green 1 has been completed and drainage from both greens to council storm water is connected and operating as planned.

We are hoping for weather to allow green 2 to be available for play between 20 and 30 August. Green no. 1 will be up to month behind that.
