# Project Synthetic Update

Despite occasional bouts of inclement weather, the Synthetics Project continues to progress satisfactorily. One machinery breakdown resulted in a change which required Green No. 1 (instead of No. 2) being attended to first. This green now has had the carpet laid and stretched. Ross Dean has had a bowl on it and all are satisfied with its play - running at 14.5 seconds and seam joins providing no problems. The carpet should quickly "walk in to" just over 16 seconds. The speed target is 17 seconds, but this may need to wait for a final carpet stretching during the summer months.

Ben O'Connell, the BBS Supervisor, was to have a week's break on this coming Thursday but unfortunately had a family bereavement and left a week early last Thursday. When he returns late this week, he will supervise the final preparation of green No. 2 (including laser levelling etc.), the laying of the underlay and then the carpet. Hopefully this will be complete by say 25 August.

Also, still to be completed are the synthetics for the ditches to both greens and the completion of the synthetic lawn grass surrounding greens 1 and 2. The latter is required to prevent small stones, seeds etc. being walked onto the greens from these surrounding walk ways.

Ross Dean is leading the member team to put in place the new rink numbers and markers in place.

**Providing** the weather is reasonable and no further unexpected problems occur, we are hoping that both greens being available for play by 10 September.
