

Who was Margaret Sadler

Margaret joined the Matua Women's Bowling Club in 1977 and became Treasurer in 1979 – 1991 In 1991-1993 she held the position of Senior Vice President, then becoming President of Matua Women's Bowling Club from 1993-1995.

Margaret was an active Umpire holding various positions in the Bay of Plenty. In 1993-1995 she held a position on the NZ Umpires Examination Board.

Margaret held 8 Bay of Plenty Centre Titles, obtaining her Gold Star in 1988 and was also selected as a Bay of Plenty Representative player. She also held positions on the Bay of Plenty Women's Bowling Centre before amalgamation.

Margaret started the Two Day Tournament as a Classic to celebrate the Matua Bowling Club's 25th Anniversary and the current trophy was donated by her family in 1998 after her sudden death.
