Bowls Bay of Plenty AGM to be held Sunday 23rd June @ Rotorua Bowling Club

Remit received from Tauranga Bowling Club

"That the Bay-wide Sevens Inter-club be played under the format of open entry with an open draw for qualifying in two sections, with the top two in each section progressing to the round-robin finals. Entry is restricted to one team, men and women, per club and all play takes place in the centralised location of Rotorua".

Reasons:


- This alleviates the uneven playing field in the qualifying, with the women playing two games in the Rotorua/Taupo division and four games in Western Bay. The men had seven clubs in the Western Bay, Eastern Bay six clubs, and Rotorua/Taupo five.
- 2. The Bay-wide must remain an open competition with the same opportunities.
- By centralising the competition in Rotorua, this reduces travel times, similar to what occurred in the divisional structure.
- 4. A team of eight players should be named before competition starts, and while positional changes can take place, no-one from outside the eight can play in any round.
