#### Remit received from Tauranga Bowling Club

“That the Bay-wide Sevens Inter-club be played under the format of open entry with an open draw for qualifying in two sections, with the top two in each section progressing to the round robin finals. Entry is restricted to one team, men and women, per club and all play takes place in the centralised location of Rotorua”.

#### Reasons:

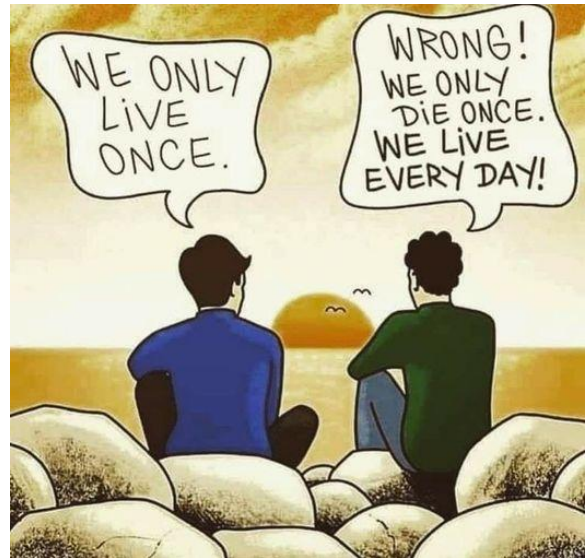
1. This alleviates the uneven playing field in the qualifying, with the women playing two games in the Rotorua/Taupo division and four games in Western Bay. The men had seven clubs in the Western Bay, Eastern Bay six clubs, and Rotorua/Taupo five.
2. The Bay-wide must remain an open competition with the same opportunities.
3. By centralising the competition in Rotorua, this reduces travel times, similar to what occurred in the divisional structure.
4. A team of eight players should be named before competition starts, and while positional changes can take place, no-one from outside the eight can play in any round.
