### **Terms of Reference for Review of Playing Programme**

**Venue: Rotorua Bowling Club, Wednesday 4th December, 2024, 6pm**

#### **Attendees:**

- ..Two representatives from each Club**
- ..Operations Committee (the meeting facilitators)**
- ..Centre President (representing the Board)**

#### **1. Introduction (President)**

- Brief overview of the playing programme and its purpose.
- Importance of the review.
- Emphasis on the importance of stakeholder engagement and the commitment to improving the playing programme.

#### **2. Objectives of the Review**

- Assess the effectiveness of the current playing programme.
- Identify strengths and weaknesses.
- Gather feedback from participants and stakeholders.
- Provide recommendations for improvement.

#### **3. Scope of the Review**

- Areas to be incorporated (Rep. programme, Centre programme, Club programmes, Coaching, Selecting, Umpires, Greens)
- Timeframe of the programme being evaluated (last season, this season).

#### **4. Methodology**

- Seek Club and stakeholder input
- Evaluate that input
- Develop potential scenarios for the 2025/2026 season

#### **5. Key Stakeholders**

- Players, Clubs, Centre, Sub Centres (Divisions), Umpires, Greenkeepers, Bowls NZ, Zones 1&2

#### **6. Timeline**

- Three weeks from 4th December for Centre to flesh out potential scenarios
- Further review meeting late January
- Final outcomes determined by mid-February
- Board approval sought
- **Changes implemented for 2025/2026 season**

At the last Bay of Plenty Centre AGM, the playing programme was discussed, and the Board committed to reviewing it. While the 2024/2025 playing programme is already set, we need to start planning for the 2025/2026 season.

Attached is an invitation for your club to attend a meeting in Rotorua in early December. We strongly encourage all clubs to participate, as our goal is to collaboratively develop a programme that benefits the entire Centre.

We anticipate holding several more meetings to discuss, refine and finalise the programme before the end of the current season. This will take into account the Bowls NZ programme, Representative fixtures, Pennants, Sixes, Memorial / Non-negotiable open tournaments and more. The meeting will be hosted by the Centre and facilitated by the Operations Committee.
